


What do you want your teen's high school experience to look like?

Teens can explore a wide range of subjects including English, math, science, religion & worldview, and more. To encapsulate the college preparatory experience, seniors prepare for their culminating project that displays their academic, personal, and spiritual growth during the four years of high school.

Diverse Electives

Fine arts, Spanish, French, technology, college & career readiness, physical education, and more set a foundation for our students' immersive and well-rounded learning.

Modified Block Schedule

Our distinct schedule gives students the time and space for deeper learning and prevents mental exhaustion. Your teen will have a traditional schedule on Monday, Tuesday, and Friday and fewer subjects with longer blocks on Wednesday and Thursday.

Discover Their Best Self

They might be only beginning to develop, but your child has passions and talents. They have a character unlike anyone else. Their friendships will be utterly unique. Everything we've built at Denver Christian encourages meaningful connections with their peers and mentors. We'll help them flourish and find success.



High schoolers enjoy expressing themselves through our performing arts program, with seasonal dramatic plays and musicals where they can take roles. Have a performer? They'll have fun in our Jazz Band, Pep Band, choir, drumline, and other clubs. Creative teens will feel excited with our varied arts and technology classes, including photography, sculpture, digital media, computer science, and more.

Athletics

Bringing home 26 state championships, the DC Thunder, our award-winning athletics program, empowers high schoolers to explore and refine their passions in sports. Whether your teen is into football, soccer, golf, basketball, cheer, cross country, baseball, volleyball, or track, they'll have room to develop their athletic skills in a healthy environment.

Clubs

Our clubs provide a safe space for your teen to socialize, enjoy their interests, and develop meaningful friendships. Co-led by a staff member, students can join groups such as Colorado Club, Art Club, Crew (small group community), Robotics, Chess, Martial Arts, and more.





It's no surprise that 97% of our graduates go to college, and a total of \$ 2.4 million worth of Merit Awards were given to the recent graduating class. We spend four years making sure they are ready to shatter expectations, thrive socially and academically, and help lead others in excellence. Here is a high-level view of how we do that at Denver Christian School.



9th GRADE

Preparation begins even in the first year of high school — our students are equipped by building a four-year plan, choosing courses that align with their interests, as well as understanding all about GPAs and high school transcripts.

10th GRADE

As our sophomores have the foundation of planning for college, we help them explore careers and prepare them for crucial life skills such as identifying strengths and areas for improvement, developing productive habits and building support networks.

11th GRADE

Our juniors further immerse themselves in practical skills that are useful as they navigate college preparation. Learning how to attend college fairs, test prep strategies, writing application essays, and understanding the financial aspects (scholarships, FAFSA, cost of attendance) of higher education are all part of our college-prep program for 11th grade.

12th GRADE

Seniors understand the steps and requirements for college and prepare to submit compelling essays. They'll also learn how to assess a college and see if it's a right fit or explore other options such as military careers, vocational school, and other opportunities. Ultimately, our 12th graders are equipped with vital skills in college success, resume writing, and career readiness.

Underneath many of the questions and priorities of the parents we talk to is one basic assumption: for good or bad, high school is going to have a huge impact on their child's character, trajectory in life, and future success. So it's worth stopping to seriously ask: what's the best high school experience you can imagine for your child?
